




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BACKGROUND

Bharatpur Eye Hospital is located in Chitwan district of southern central Nepal, is a non-profit charitable organization, providing high quality comprehensive eye care services at affordable cost to local as well as patients from neighboring districts; eg. Gorkha, Lamjung, Nawalpur, Tanahu, Makawanpur, Parsa & Dhading comprising of about two million populations. In addition to Base Hospital, BEH has established several eye care centres in different locations to provide basic eye care facility to the community. BEH currently has following networks of eye care centres in under mentioned locations.

The hospital, named after Late His Majesty King Mahendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev, is located in the delightful city of Bharatpur, the capital of Chitwan district, by the bank of Narayani River, a place of pilgrimage of the Hindus. The hospital is among the few pioneer established eye hospitals of Nepal. It has an area of 4 Bighas, three-fourths of which is occupied by the hospital building itself, and the remainder is cultivated as forest land.

Bharatpur Eye Hospital was established in 1987

under the aegis of Nepal Netra Jyoti Sangh (NNJS-National Society for Comprehensive Eye Care Service). The hospital building was constructed with financial and technical support from BCCI foundation Pakistan. Initially, it was established to provide eye care services in Chitwan district only but in the pursuit of growth and expansion with the support from various international organizations, relentless efforts and commitment put in, by its staff members and continued cooperation from local community, have made it possible for BEH to serve beyond Chitwan.

The hospital was constructed with the grant assistance from the Bank of Commerce and Credit International (BCCI), Pakistan and the contribution made by His Excellency Mr. Gulam Ishaq Khan, who was then the President of Pakistan. The hospital building was formally inaugurated by the Late His Majesty King Birendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev on March 31, 1988 in the presence of Late Her Majesty Queen Aishwarya and the President of Pakistan.

There is only one eye hospital known as King Mahendra Memorial Eye Hospital (KMMEH), recently renamed as Bharatpur Eye Hospital, in Bharatpur apart from recently developed eye department of the teaching hospital. (Medical Colleges, there are two Private medical colleges, which are having small eye department just to fulfill the requirement of the medical college). The adjunct districts of Chitwan are Dhading, Gorkha, Makawanpur, Lamjung, Tanahu, Parsa and Nawalparasi. All these districts are the catchments areas of Bharatpur Eye Hospital Chitwan. Total population of these catchments area is about 1.5 millions.











Comparative of Fiscal Year 2017.18 & 2018.19




OCULAR SURGERIES:



SPECIALTY SERVICES

PEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY SERVICE

The pediatric ophthalmology service has been running smoothly as a separate department, well equipped with all the necessary instruments and treatment facilities. Ophthalmologists, optometrists and orthoptists work together to provide quality service to the patients. In FY 2018-2019 a total of 23,370 children were provided out patient services. Majority of children were diagnosed with conjunctivitis and refractive errors

CORNEA SERVICE

In FY 2018-2019 a total of 4,077 patients visited the cornea clinic. Keratitis was the major corneal problem followed by kerato-conjunctivitis and corneal ulcer. Corneal transplant service started since 2017 and 35 patients underwent corneal transplant in 2018-2019 including both therapeutic and optical purpose. Since the establishment of the cornea collection center ten corneas have been collected so far.



VITREO-RETINAL SERVICE

It is well established service headed by senior consultant Vitreo-Retinal Surgeon. Almost all necessary equipment's like OCT, USG, Fundus Photography, FFA & Green Laser are available for diagnosis and treatment of retinal problems. It has also been established as a training center where currently one ophthalmologist is doing his fellowship in retina. In 2018/2019 retina departments provided service to a total 5,021 patients of which 381 underwent various retinal surgeries, 178 patients were given intravitreal injections and 378 patient underwent LASER treatment.

Of the total patients 2,338 were diagnosed and treated for diabetic retinopathy. Patients not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from neighboring county like India are provided retinal service in the hospital. 748 patients with diabetes mellitus were screened through 10 diabetic retinopathy camps and 59

patients referred to this hospital for further treatment.



GLAUCOMA SERVICE

A total of 772 patients were diagnosed with glaucoma suspect and glaucoma in 2018/2019 and 15 patients were done surgery. Glaucoma clinic is equipped with instruments like Goldman Perimetry, Frequency Doubling Test (FDT), Optic Disc Photography and OCT that helped in diagnosis and treatment of glaucoma patient.

LOW VISION SERVICE

This hospital has provided low vision services since last two years. All kinds of devices available in this hospital. Optical devices, non-optical and electronic devices which are much more significant for low-vision and blind patients. Altogether 64 patients (Male: 38, Female: 26) with low vision were assessed. Special low vision devices were offered to 6 patients. With the increase in the number of retina patients the need of low vision care is increasing and near future we will have a well-equipped low vision clinic with optometrists trained in low vision.

TELE-OPHTHALMOLOGY SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital started telemedicine service with aim to provide door to door appropriate eye care treatment services to the patients. Through this facilities base hospital are connected to ECCs and ophthalmic Assistants at ECC can communicate with ophthalmologist at base hospital to confirm diagnosis so as to provide appropriate treatment to patients. We are strengthening the service, so that the community needy people can have easy access to the eye care service from Eye Care Center through base hospital. We have now started tele-ophthalmology service from all eye care centers.



LAB SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has a well-equipped and facilitated laboratory services for patient undergoing ocular surgeries since 2012. Almost majority of all required laboratory investigations

including culture and sensitivity are performed in the lab. A total of 5824 patients underwent different lab investigations in 2018-2019.




EYE CARE CENTER PERFORMANCE

OPD PATIENTS

A total of 42,103 patient were treated through eye care centers excluding city clinic at Bharatpur height. It is around 20% of the overall patients served in 2018-19. There has been increase in

the number of patients in all primary eye care centers in this year compared to previous year. Parsa Eye Care Centre had the highest number of patients among all ECCs.

Eye care centers provide primary eye care services and referral patients for surgery and those require specialized care. 972 patients have

been recorded as referred from different sources and out of that 145 have been referred from primary eye care centers.

OUTREACH EYE CARE ACTIVITIES

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has provided service not only to patient who come to the hospital but also to patient in remote areas who do not have access to the hospital through various outreach activities. In addition to the conduction of DST camps, cataract surgical camps, diabetic retinopathy camp and school screening program throughout the year, BEH has also been involved in awareness campaigns through training to FCHVs, Drug Retailers, School Teachers

and Women Groups with the aim of reducing preventable blindness in the community.

A total of 29012 patients had their eye examination in various outreach eye care

programs conducted in year 2018-19. This is around 14% of the patient served in this year.



RESEARCH

VIEW (VILLAGE INTEGRATED EYE WORKERS TRIAL)

A program conducted under joint collaboration of Bharatpur Eye Hospital, NNJS, SEVA Nepal, F.I.Proctor Foundation, UCSF and SightLife, USA. Initially in the year Feb,2014 F.I.Proctor Foundation started a community randomized trial for detecting and treating corneal abrasion from trained Female Community Health Volunteer. This trial was completed in the year 2017.

In August 2017, SightLife took over the VIEW-I activities currently known as blindness prevention program, a community randomized trial conduct by F.I. Proctor Foundation, USA from 2014-2017. Where 117 trained Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) from nine and three VDCs of Nawalpur and Chitwan districts respectively involved in detecting and treating corneal abrasions in their respective communities. SightLife founded in 1969 is the only non-profit global health organization solely focused on eliminating corneal blindness around the world through prevention programs, eye banking and corneal transplants.

VIEW-II-Pilot Study is the second phase of VIEW study lunched in June 2018 by Francis I. Proctor Foundation, UCSF in collaboration with Seva Foundation and Bharatpur Eye Hospital. This is a cluster randomized trial aims to determine whether a community based screening program is more effective than cataract camp approach, in detecting more cases of glaucoma, DR and AMD and also to determine whether a community health volunteer program increases the rate of cataract surgery compared to a no program

where trained Female Community Health Volunteer go door to door and examine vision status of above 50 years people with the help of tumbling “E” chart and refer them on the basis of visual acuity criteria to nearby eye care centers. This pilot study also conducted screening camp in different communities of East Chitwan. Screening includes fundus photography, auto-refraction, IOP measurement of 50+ years people and setting referral mechanism to those suspected with glaucoma, DR and AMD and linking them to hospital care or eye care centers. After the successful pilot study another study (VIEW-II) has been officially started from February 2019. This is also a cluster randomized trial aims to identify whether an intensive screening with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and linkage to hospital care can reduce the number of blindness due to glaucoma, DR and AMD compared to no intervention area. This study includes intensive community screening of 60+ years people with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and measurement of IOP and referring suspected clients to Bharatpur Eye Hospital for further care. These people will be followed for next 5 years. Baseline census is being conducted at the starting of the study and final census will be conducted after next 4 years to compare the vision status of that community. Study Team includes 1 Study Co-ordinator, 1 Assistant Study Co-ordinator, 1 Referral Manager (Ophthalmic Assistant), 10 Screening Members (Ophthalmic Assistant), 6 Field Supervisors, 25 Census Workers and 2 Drivers.

This pilot study is still undergoing.

VIEW II the real study was launched in April 2019. This is a cluster randomized trial, randomization units include toles/wards of municipality/rural municipality in Chitwan and Nawalpur districts. The main objective of the study is to determine whether a community-based intervention screening program for ocular disease involving OCT, intraocular pressure testing and enhanced linkage to care improves ocular outcomes.




Corneal Ulcer Prevention Program

- ◆ FCHV have treated more than 3000 cases of corneal abrasion.
- ◆ 96% of the cases detected and treated by FCHVs have been healed.
- ◆ The final study finding is yet to be released.
- ◆ Work is being continued as corneal ulcer prevention program.



HOSPITAL CONTRIBUTION (2018/019)

Bharatpur Eye Hospital encourages patients to pay for services as much as possible. However, keeping in mind the socio-economic realities, BEH dose offer subsidized or completely free services to poor and deserving populations. As a

policy, BEH does not deny eye care to any person based on any demographic, regional, social or economic denomination. NRs 2,51,47,859 has been contributed to 8,262 patients by the hospital in the year 2018/19.



SUMMARY

In 2018/19 a total of 2,08,640 patients were served through Bharatpur Eye Hospital, its eye care centers and outreach activities. More female patients than males are found to be seeking the eye care services. Of the total patients 53.4% are females and 46.6% are males. 7,413 patients were provided major and minor surgical care and majority 81.92% were cataract surgeries. With the motive to provide more comprehensive and quality service, we have been able to establish new sub specialty services and upgraded the existing ones.

Conjunctivitis and refractive error were the major ocular problems in children and 50 children were operated for cataract. We restored sight of 72 patient blind due to corneal opacity through corneal transplants and collected 10 corneas since the establishment of cornea collection center.

In 2018/19 almost 3.5% of the total patients were retina patients of which 1,017 of them

received various retina treatments including surgeries, laser treatment and Avastin injection. Patient not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from India come for their retina checkup and this has been as referral centre for retina.

Outreach programs is one of the major component of hospital where we reach the unreached people and provide services through wide range of community based activities. This year a total of 29,012 patients were seen through various outreach activities that includes DST camp, surgical camps, monthly clinics at health posts, DR camps and refraction camps. 3,024 of sight restoring cataract surgeries were done through a camp which is 40.79% of total cataract surgeries were performed in 2018/19.

We screened 30,823 schools going children from 75 schools both public and private in Chitwan, Nawalparasi and adjoining districts and provided glasses to 1,052 school children.







Mr. Maila Moktan, 59 years of age, permanent resident of Hariwon Municipality-6 Dhurkauli, Sarlahi District, Nepal was having eye problem since 3 years. His vision was gradually deteriorating going down slowly and finding difficult to do his regular work. He used to think that this is due to his age and did not know his sight will be regained after surgery. Once, there was a marriage ceremony in his neighboring house and during the visit, his Nephew's friends shared that they also had the same problem and after surgery they regained their sight. The information what Maila's Nephew received from his friend, he shared with his Kaka (Uncle) at his home when he returned from the marriage ceremony.

Maila Moktan is an unmarried man having 3 brothers and 2 sisters who are all married. So, including their Kids now altogether, there are 21 members in the family. They are all farmer and main source of income is agriculture and sometime they do agriculture labor too.

One day in the evening, his Bhatij (Nephew) Sanka Man Moktan was returning home from the market. He heard about the free eye camp Conducted By

Nepal Netrajyoti Sangh Bharatpur Eye Hospital with the Supported by DAK Foundation at "Bal Poshad Program" Eye Care Centre Hariwon Municipality, Sarlahi. He shared the same information with his Uncle Maila Moktan. Next day morning, Maila Moktan and his Nephew went to the eye camp, the eye camp team examined his eyes. His eye vision in both eyes was PL due to cataract. The team advised for the cataract surgery of left eye and admitted for surgery. After cataract surgery he has got 6/18 vision at the time of discharge (next day post-operative vision). He was so happy and shared his happiness with his Nephew as well as eye camp team. At the same time he requested for the Operation of his Next Eye. Then we discussed about next eye surgery and told him that the surgery will be done after two days. After two days we performed the right eye cataract surgery and next day of the operation, we opened the pad he thanked to all the eye camp team members.

He is now staying back in his home and regained a vision of 6/12 and now he can engage in regular agricultural work and is taking care of his life and family


