BACKGROUND

Bharatpur Eye Hospital is located in Chitwan district of southern central Nepal, is a non-profit charitable organization, providing high quality comprehensive eye care services at affordable cost to local as well as patients from neighboring districts; eg. Gorkha, Lamjung, Nawalpur, Tanahu, Makawanpur, Parsa & Dhading comprising of about two million populations. In addition to Base Hospital, BEH has established several eye care centres in different locations to provide basic eye care facility to the community. BEH currently has following networks of eye care centres in under mentioned locations.

The hospital, named after Late His Majesty King Mahendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev, is located in the delightful city of Bharatpur, the capital of Chitwan district, by the bank of Narayani River, a place of pilgrimage of the Hindus. The hospital is among the few pioneer established eye hospitals of Nepal. It has an area of 4 Bighas, three-fourths of which is occupied by the hospital building itself, and the remainder is cultivated as forest land.

Bharatpur Eye Hospital was established in 1987 under the aegis of Nepal Netra Jyoti Sangh (NNJS-National Society for Comprehensive Eye Care Service). The hospital building was constructed with financial and technical support from BCCI foundation Pakistan. Initially, it was established to provide eye care services in Chitwan district only but in the pursuit of growth and expansion with the support from various international organizations, relentless efforts and commitment put in, by its staff members and continued cooperation from local community, have made it possible for BEH to serve beyond Chitwan.

The hospital was constructed with the grant assistance from the Bank of Commerce and Credit International (BCCI), Pakistan and the contribution made by His Excellency Mr. Gulam Ishaq Khan, who was then the President of Pakistan. The hospital building was formally inaugurated by the Late His Majesty King Birendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev on March 31, 1988 in the presence of Late Her Majesty Queen Aishwarya and the President of Pakistan.

There is only one eye hospital known as King Mahendra Memorial Eye Hospital (KMMEH), recently renamed as Bharatpur Eye Hospital, in Bharatpur apart from recently developed eye department of the teaching hospital. (Medical Colleges, there are two Private medical colleges, which are having small eye department just to fulfill the requirement of the medical college). The adjunct districts of Chitwan are Dhading, Gorkha, Makawanpur, Lamjung, Tanahu, Parsa and Nawalparasi. All these districts are the catchments areas of Bharatpur Eye Hospital Chitwan. Total population of these catchments area is about 1.5 millions.







MAP OF FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF NEPAL











A total of one Lakh sixty three thousand and one hundred forty eight patients were served through Bharatpur Eye Hospital and all its networks including various outreach activities in the year 2019.20. This is decreased by 18.25% compared to the previous year 2018.19.

Females were more than males for seeking eye care with 53.2% of females and 46.8% of males.








Bharatpur Eye Hospital and its networks provided service to a total of 1, 63,148 patients in the year 2019.20. 1,03,760 (63.59%) took their service from the base hospital and CBH, 32,456 (19.89%) were served in eye care centers and 26,932 (16.50%) took their service from the different outreach programs. There is decrease in the number of patient by 24.55% because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Comparative of Fiscal Year 2018.19 & 2019.20










OCULAR SURGERIES:




SPECIALTY SERVICES, OPHTHALMOLOGY

PEDIATRIC SERVICE

The pediatric ophthalmology service has been running smoothly as a separate department, well equipped with all the necessary instruments and treatment facilities. Ophthalmologists, Optometrists and Orthoptists work together to provide quality service to the patients. In FY 2019.20 a total of 10,632 children were provided out patient services. Majority of children were diagnosed with conjunctivitis and refractive errors. Due to COVID number of pediatric patients have decreased.

CORNEA SERVICE

In FY 2019.20 a total of 2,781 patients visited the cornea clinic. Keratitis was the major corneal problem followed by kerato-conjunctitvitis and corneal ulcer. Corneal transplant service started since 2017 and 16 patients underwent corneal transplant in 2019.20 including both therapeutic and optical purpose. Since the establishment of the cornea collection center ten corneas have been collected so far.

VITREO-RETINA SERVICE

It is well established service headed by senior consultant Vitreo-Retinal Surgeon. Almost all necessary equipment's like OCT, USG, Fundus Photography, FFA & Green Laser are available for diagnosis and treatment of retinal problems. It has also been established as a training center where currently one ophthalmologist is doing his fellowship in retina. In 2019.20 retina departments provided service to a total 3,856 patients of which 108 underwent various retinal surgeries, 25 patients were given intravitral injections, 301 patient underwent LASER treatment and 271 Avastin injection administered.

Of the total patients 1610 were diagnosed and treated for diabetic retinopathy. Patients not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from neighboring county like India are provided retinal service in the hospital.

LOW VISION & CONTACT LENS SERVICE

This hospital has provided low vision services since last two years. All kinds of devices available in this hospital. Optical devices, non-optical and electronic devices which are much more significant for low-vision and blind patients. Altogether 29 patients (Male: 16, Female: 13) with low vision were assessed. Special low vision devices were offered to 2 patients. With the increase in the number of retina patients the need of low vision care is increasing and near future we will have a well-equipped low vision clinic with optometrists trained in low vision. In year 2019.20 60 pcs of contact lens were prescribed.

TELE-OPHTHALMOLOGY SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital started telemedicine service with aim to provide door to door appropriate eye care treatment services to the patients. Through this facilities base hospital are connected to ECCs and ophthalmic Assistants at ECC can communicate with ophthalmologist at base hospital to confirm diagnosis so as to provide appropriate treatment to patients. We are strengthening the service, so that the community needy people can have easy access to the eye care service from Eye Care Center through base hospital. We have now started teleophthalmology service from all eye care centers.







LAB SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has a well-equipped and facilitated laboratory services for patient undergoing ocular surgeries since 2012. Almost majority of all required laboratory investigations including culture and sensitivity are performed in the lab. A total of 5492 patients underwent different lab investigations in 2019.2020.

RESEARCH

VIEW (VILLAGE INTEGRATED EYE WORKERS TRIAL)

A program conducted under joint collaboration of Bharatpur Eye Hospital, NNJS, SEVA Nepal, F.I.Proctor Foundation, UCSF and SightLife, USA. Initially in the year Feb,2014 F.I.Proctor Foundation started a community randomized trial for detecting and treating corneal abrasion from trained Female Community Health Volunteer. This trial was completed in the year 2017.

In August 2017, SightLife took over the VIEW-I activities currently known as blindness prevention program, a community randomized trial conduct by F.I. Proctor Foundation, USA from 2014-2017. Where 117 trained Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) from nine and three VDCs of Nawalparasi and Chitwan districts respectively involved in detecting and treating corneal abrasions in their respective communities. SightLife founded in 1969 is the only non-profit global health organization solely focused on eliminating corneal blindness around the world through prevention programs, eye banking and corneal transplants.

VIEW-II-Pilot Study is the second phase of VIEW study lunched in June 2018 by Francis I. Proctor Foundation, UCSF in collaboration with Seva Foundation and Bharatpur Eye Hospital. This is a cluster randomized trial aims to determine whether a community based screening program is more effective than cataract camp approach, in detecting more cases of glaucoma, DR and AMD and also to determine whether a community health volunteer program increases the rate of cataract surgery compared to a no program

where trained Female Community Health Volunteer go door to door and examine vision status of above 50 years people with the help of tumbling "E" chart and refer them on the basis of visual acuity criteria to nearby eye care centers. This pilot study also conducted screening camp in different communities of east Chitwan. Screening includes fundus photography, Autorefraction, IOP measurement of 50+ years people and setting referral mechanism to those suspected with glaucoma, DR and AMD and linking them to hospital care or eye care centers. After the successful pilot study another study (VIEW-II) has been officially started from February 2019. This is also a cluster randomized trial aims to identify whether an intensive screening with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and linkageto hospital care can reduce the number of blindness due to glaucoma, DR and AMD compared to no intervention area. This study includes intensive community screening of 60+ years people with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and measurement of IOP and referring suspected clients to Bharatpur Eye Hospital for further care. These people will be followed for next 5 years. Baseline census is being conducted at the starting of the study and final census will be conducted after next 4 years to compare the vision status of that community. Study Team includes 1 Study Co-ordintor, 1 Assistant Study Co-ordinator, 1 Referral Manager (Ophthalmic Assistant), 10 Screening Members (Ophthalmic Assistant), 6 Field Supervisors, 25 Census Workers and 2 Drivers.

ANNUAL REPORT



Since August 2017, SightLife is taking over the VIEW I activities where we have 117 trained Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) from nine and three VDCs of Nawalparasi and Chitwan districts respectively involved in detecting and treating corneal abrasions in their communities. SightLife founded in 1969 is the only non-profit global health organization solely focused on eliminating corneal blindness around the world through prevention programs, eye banking and corneal transplants.

VIEW-II-Pilot Study is the second phase of VIEW study lunched in June 2018 by Francis I. Proctor Foundation UCSF in collaboration with Seva Foundation and Bharatpur Eye Hospital. This study aims to determine whether a community –based screening program is more effective than cataract camp approach, in detecting more cases of glaucoma, DR and AMD and also to determine whether a community health volunteer program increases the rate of cataract surgery compared to a no program. This pilot study is still undergoing.

VIEW II the real study was launched in April 2019. This is cluster randomized trial, randomization units include toles/wards of municipality/rural municipality in Chitwan and Nawalpur districts. The main objective of the study is to determine whether a community –based intervention screening program for ocular disease involving OCT, intraocular pressure testing and enhanced linkage to care improves ocular outcomes.





SUMMARY

Despite the challenge faced due to the corona virus pandemic, Bharatpur eye hospital, its eye care centers and the outreach programs provided service to a total of 1,63,148 patients which is just 24.5% less than the previous year. There are more females (53.2%) than males (46.8%) seeking for eye care. Sixty four percentage of the patients got service from the base hospital alone. This year a total of 5, 143 ocular surgeries were performed of which 3829 (74.5%) the sight are restoring cataract surgeries.

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has been providing all level of patient care through specialty services by strictly following the safety precautions for the corona virus. Conjunctivitis was the major problem among children followed by refractive errors and sight was restored in 64 children through cataract surgeries. We were able to perform corneal transplant in 16 patients. In 2019.20 retina departments provided service to a total 3,856 patients of which 108 underwent

various retinal surgeries. The patient seeking glaucoma care have been increasing very rapidly since the establishment of glaucoma as separate department, 1014 glaucoma patient were treated in this year.

Total of 51,307 patients received basic primary eye care service through our eye care centers distributed in different geographies. 1,904 patients were referred from the centers and majority were referred for cataract surgeries.

Outreach programs is one of the major component of hospital where we reach the unreached people and provide services through wide range of community based activities. This year a total of 26,932 patients were seen through various outreach activities that includes DST camp, surgical camps, monthly clinics at health posts, DR camps and refraction camps. 1,568 of sight restoring cataract surgeries were done through a camp which is 41% of total cataract surgeries done in 2019.20.



Shree Devi Khushawa, 65 years old female permanent residence of Simraungadh-7 in Bara district of Nepal attended the free surgical eye camp organized by Bharatpur Eye Hospital on 27 January 2021.

She was a farmer with very poor economic status. She lived in a village with her grandsons and daughter in law. Her life turned to be more miserable and difficult since her only son who was the bread winner of the whole family died in an accident year's back.

She had noticed decrease in her eyesight since many years which gradually deteriorated, she had no one to take care of her and take her for eye treatments so she was forced to struggle with very poor vision since many years. She shares her story that her daughter in law took her to the nearby eye hospital for the eye checkup when her vision was so much deteriorated that she was almost blind but she had to return back home without being treated because she could not afford to pay for the surgery.

One day a women form her neighboring house who knew about the free surgical eye camp being conducted by Nepal Netra Jyoti Bharatpur Eye Hospital Supported by DAK Foundation in Simraungadh Eye Care Centre, suggested her to go in that camp for her eye surgery. Her one of the grandson brought her to the camp site on the day of 27th January 2021. On examination it was found that she could only perceive light in both eyes and diagnosed with matured cataract in both eyes.

Her right eye was successfully operated and the next day when patch was opened, a glow of smile emerged from the poor old face as she could she again. She could not express her happiness in words. Her vision in right eye was 6/9. She was happy that now she can go to work again to feed the little grandsons and manage the family. The free surgical eye camp gave a new life to her and she was thankful for the bottom of the heart for all those who were involved for her treatment.

Family occupation: Agriculture, enough to manage family from the product of own land.

Family: wife, one son and 3 daughters, all the children are married and all are in their own

family. Bechan and his wife are staying with his son.

Duration of blindness: completely blind since 2 years, demising of vision since 3-4 years gradually.

Reasons for not coming hospital earlier: up to two years back he was managing work somehow, and not feels important to go. When the vision is gone down completely, then started thinking where to go, how much is the cost of treatment and looking for the person who can help to go to the hospital, by that time COVID19 started and staying at home.

How he is reach the eye camp: Municipality Simrongard has done publicity house to house through school students/Female community Health volunteers and received the information from female community health volunteers. Then





his son has brought him to the eye camp for surgery.

Person who is taking care at home: His wife is taking care, as Bechan, he is getting best care from his wife. His wife is supporting day to day or routines such as: Bathroom, changing dress, food, toilets etc.

Right eye performed surgery, after surgery he has got 6/12 vision the next day of surgery. The eye camp team asked what is exciting to see, Buchan is excited to see his 4 years granddaughter. He shared that grand daughter is the one who is talking, playing and helping to go to the out from the room and taking back to the room.

He also shared that, he had no hope to see her face again, thanks to the eye camp team for sight restoring and now excited to see the grand daughter.




