BACKGROUND

Bharatpur Eye Hospital which is located in Chitwan district of southern central Nepal, is a non-profit charitable organization, providing high quality comprehensive eye care services at affordable cost to local as well as patients from neighboring districts; eg. Gorkha, Lamjung, Nawalpur, Tanahu, Makawanpur, Parsa & Dhading comprising of about two million populations. In addition to Base Hospital, BEH has established several eye care centres in different locations to provide basic eye care facility to the community. The hospital, initially named after then late King Mahendra Bir Bikram Shah Dev, was given new name Bharatpur Eye Hospital after Nepal became Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal. Bharatpur,

the second largest city out of Kathmandu valley in Bagmati Province (Province number 3) is a delightful and emerging city of Nepal. It is situated at the bank of Holy Narayani River, thus is a holy place of pilgrimage for the Hindus. The hospital is among the few pioneer eye hospital in Nepal established on 31st March 1987 under the aegis of Nepal Netra Jyoti Sangh (National Society for Comprehensive Eye Care Service). The main hospital building was constructed with the financial and technical support from Bank of Commerce and Credit International (BCCI foundation Pakistan) and contribution made by His Excellency Mr. Gulam Ishaq Khan, then President of Pakistan. Initially it was providing eye care services to the people of Chitwan district but in the pursuit of growth and expansion from the support of various national and international organizations, noble individual donors, relentless efforts and commitment put in by its staff members and continued cooperation from local community, BEH have been able to extend its services to its neighboring districts and also the people living across the border.


Apart from providing high quality eye care services at affordable cost, BEH has already established itself as an esteemed institute and is conducting residency program for MD students, Bachelor in Optometry and Visual Sciences, PCL Ophthalmic Sciences and clinical posting to nursing students studying PCL, Bachelor and Master level and PCL in General Medicine. 

MAP OF FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF NEPAL





As compared to previous year there is decrease in the number of patient served by 17.82% because of the impact of COVID-19 pandemic.




Gender Wise Proportion



Fiscal Year 2020.21






OCULAR SURGERIES

A total of 29,155 patients were treated through Nepal Government Social Health Insurance Policy, where patient patients underwent various investigations as well as different medical and surgical treatments.




SPECIALTY SERVICES, OPHTHALMOLOGY

PEDIATRIC SERVICE

The pediatric ophthalmology service has been running smoothly as a separate department, well equipped with all the necessary instruments and treatment facilities. Ophthalmologists, Optometrists and Orthoptists work together to provide quality service to the patients. In FY 2020.21 a total of 9,569 children were provided out patient services. Majority of children were diagnosed with conjunctivitis and refractive errors. Due to COVID-19 pandemic number of pediatric patients have decreased.

CORNEA SERVICE

In FY 2020.21 a total of 1,689 patients visited the cornea clinic. Keratitis was the major corneal problem followed by kerato-conjunctivitis and corneal ulcer. Corneal transplant service started since 2017 and 10 patients underwent corneal transplant in 2020.21 including both therapeutic and optical purpose. Since the establishment of the cornea collection center ten corneas have been collected so far.

VITREO-RETINA SERVICE

It is well established service headed by senior consultant Vitreo-Retinal Surgeon. Almost all necessary equipment's like OCT, USG, Fundus Photography, FFA & Green Laser are available for diagnosis and treatment of retinal problems. It has also been established as a training center where currently one ophthalmologist is doing his fellowship in retina. In 2020.21 retina departments provided service to a total 3,125 patients of which 138 underwent various retinal surgeries, 258 patients were given intravitreal injections, 321 patient underwent LASER treatment.

Of the total patients 1610 were diagnosed and treated for diabetic retinopathy. Patients not only from Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from neighboring county like India are provided retinal service in the hospital.

LOW VISION & CONTACT LENS SERVICE

BEH is providing low vision services since last 2 years. Low Vision Clinic has complete sets of all low vision devices. Optical devices, non-optical and electronic devices which are much more significant for low-vision and blind patients. Altogether 23 patients (Male: 11, Female: 12) with low vision were assessed. Special low vision devices were offered to 2 patients. With the increase in the number of retina patients the need of low vision care is increasing and near future we will have a well-equipped low vision clinic with optometrists trained in low vision. In the year 2020-21, a total of 47 patients were prescribed contact lenses.

TELE-OPHTHALMOLOGY SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital started telemedicine service with aim to provide door to door appropriate eye care treatment services to the patients. Through this facilities base hospital are connected to ECCs and ophthalmic assistants at ECC can communicate with ophthalmologist at base hospital to confirm diagnosis so as to provide appropriate treatment to patients. BEH is strengthening its Tele-Ophthalmology Services with linking up all its Eye Care Centers with the Base Hospital so that patients living in communities will also have access to hospital based subspecialist doctors. All ECC are already linked with Tele-Ophthalmology Services.





LAB SERVICE

Bharatpur Eye Hospital has its own laboratory since 2012. It is a well-equipped lab that provides high quality service to its patients. All routine investigations, Culture and Sensitivity,

different staining services and serological tests are performed in the laboratory. A total of 3902 patients underwent different lab investigations in 2020.21



RESEARCH PROJECT- VILLAGE INTEGRATED EYE WORKERS TRIAL (VIEW)

View I - Village –integrated eye workers for prevention of corneal ulcers (VIEW): a cluster-randomized trial. A cluster-randomized trial was performed in Nepal to determine the effectiveness of a Community-based corneal ulcer prevention program (clinicaltrials.gov #NCT01969786). The randomization unit was the Village Development Committee (VDC). In the intervention arm, pre-existing Female Community Health Volunteers (FCHVs) were trained to diagnose corneal

abrasions and provide a three-day course of ophthalmic antimicrobials. A door-to-door census including corneal photographs was performed in all communities each year of the three-year study. The primary outcome was incident corneal opacity ulceration on photography, as determined by masked graders assessment of corneal photographs. Completed in 2017, SightLife took over this intervention as the corneal prevention program and is still continuing.





VIEW-II- Pilot Study is the second phase of VIEW study lunched in June 2018 by Francis I. Proctor Foundation, UCSF in collaboration with Seva Foundation and Bharatpur Eye Hospital. This is a cluster randomized trial aims to determine whether a community based screening program is more effective than cataract camp approach, in detecting more cases of glaucoma, DR and AMD and also to determine whether a community health volunteer program increases the rate of cataract surgery compared to a no program where trained Female Community Health Volunteer go door to door and examine vision status of above 50 years people with the help of tumbling “E” chart and refer them on the basis of visual acuity criteria to nearby eye care centers. This pilot study also conducted screening camp in different communities of east Chitwan. Screening includes fundus photography, Auto-refraction, IOP measurement of 50+ years

people and setting referral mechanism to those suspected with glaucoma, DR and AMD and linking them to hospital care or eye care centers. After the successful pilot study another study (VIEW-II) has been officially started from February 2019. This is also a cluster randomized trial aims to identify whether an intensive screening with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and linkage to hospital care can reduce the number of blindness due to glaucoma, DR and AMD compared to no intervention area. This study includes intensive community screening of 60+ years people with OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) and measurement of IOP and referring suspected clients to Bharatpur Eye Hospital for further care. These people will be followed for next 5 years. Baseline census is being conducted at the starting of the study and final census will be conducted after next 4 years to compare the vision status of that community.









SUMMARY

In the year 2020-21, a total of 1,34,067 patients were served through Bharatpur Eye Hospital, its eye care centers and community outreach activities. More female patients than males are found to be seeking the eye care services. Of the total patients 52.57% are females and 47.11% are males. A total of 6007 patients underwent surgery out of which 5,439 (91%) were major and 568 (9%) minor surgeries.

Conjunctivitis and refractive error were the major ocular problems in children with only 45 children were operated for cataract. BEH performed 91 corneal transplantation surgeries and restored the sights. BEH also harvests cornea and so far 10 corneas have been harvested.

In the year 2020.21, a total of 3125 patients were treated from Retina Clinic out of which 138 were retinal surgery, 258 Avastin injections and 321 lasers applications. Similarly, 1145

Fundus Photography, 1799 OCT and 20 FFA were performed. Patient not only form Chitwan and neighboring districts but also from India come for their retina checkup and this has been as referral Centre for retina. Outreach programs is one of the major component of hospital where we reach the unreached people and provide services through wide range of community based activities. This year a total of 15,262 patients were seen through various outreach activities that includes DST camp, surgical camps, monthly clinics at health posts, DR camps and refraction camps. 1,143 of sight restoring cataract surgeries were done through a camp which is 51.11% of total cataract surgeries done in 2020.21.

We screened 2,612 schools going children from 4 schools both public and private in Chitwan, Nawalparasi and adjoining districts and provided glass to 70 school children.



Man Bahadur is a homeless person. He is staying at the house of his cousin. His wife had passed away 20 years ago and he do not have children to take his care. He does not have any land and he used to get some money for his livelihood by working as a daily wages laborer in villager's farm. The earnings he made was just hard enough for his livelihood. Since last 3 years his vision was sharply declining and he was not able to work properly and his living was compromised but he was getting some mercy of villagers and was managing his livelihood. But for last 6 months his vision had become much worse and was visually handicapped and was not able to walk out of his home. Hence his livelihood totally depended on mercy of his neighbors and villagers. Sometime he used to have some food but sometime he had to stay without food. One day was a lucky day for Man Bahadur when a villager who was also having cloudy vision asked him to

visit to a free surgical eye camp in his neighbor village. Both of them attended to surgical eye camp organized in next village of their residence. Both of them got operated. Man Bahadur's right eye was operated and he regained back his lost vision. His vision was 6/18 on first day after surgery. He also got free medicines and instructions about how to use medicines and take care of his eye. He was very happy and there were no instruments to measure his happiness but his smiling face was enough to judge it. He was very thankful to BEH and surgical team which operated his eye and also thankful to SEVA Foundation which had supported the surgical eye camp. He told us that he is once again capable to work and live independently. He told us that he will resume his previous work and live with dignity and self-reliance.

Putali Chepang had poor vision in her both eyes. Her left eye was operated 4 years back at Charaudi organized by BEH. She was married at the age of 14 (love marriage) and have 4 children all of them live separately.

Her husband passed away 4 years back and since then she is living with her eldest son. She looks after the grandchildren and she also helps in the agricultural activities of her children. The land was not enough to produce food for the whole year, but only for 7-8 months. For the remaining 4-5 months her son and daughter in law used to go for labour work away from home. Hence Putali Maya had to take full care of the home and

her grandchildren. Her vision in right eye was very poor and she was having problem because of it. BEH was organizing free surgical eye in Benighat. She knew about it from one of the field worker. Her house is 10 km far from eye camp site however she managed to visit to camp and got her right eye operated. She regained back her lost vision in right eye and was extremely happy. She expressed her gratitude to BEH and the donor of the eye camp. She told us that now she can take care of her grand-children and at the same time help to her daughter in law in their farming. She told us that there is no other happiness than to live life with pride.






